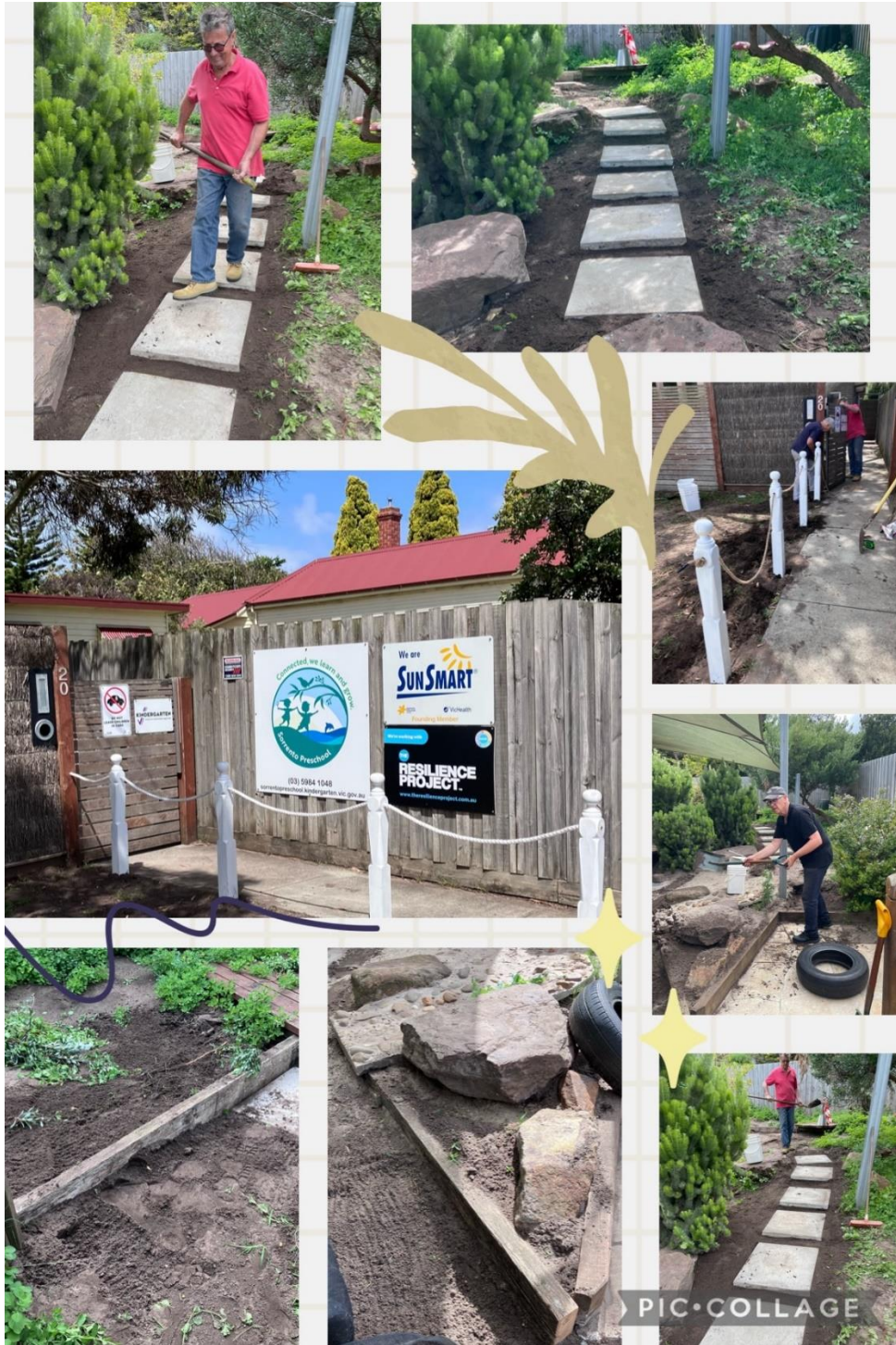
Now a 'best offer' gets the prize!
